Allyson Glover, Programme Director, has been a driving force in Unlocking Potential since it was launched in 2004. She said, "In April we will have supported graduates in Cornwall for ten years and created more than 1000 jobs. Naturally, we are still in touch with many of the graduates, yet we also know that many have further developed their careers in and out of the county and we also know a good number of them have gone on to set up and grow their own businesses; some are even running those businesses they started with!"

10,000 apprentices, 10,000 careers through Cornwall College

Cornwall College Group helped over 10,000 people into apprenticeships in the last ten years. The official figure was released at the start of National Apprenticeship Week, which ran between the 3rd and the 7th of March.

Kim Conchie, Chief Executive of Cornwall Chamber of Commerce said: "Apprenticeships have taken a bit of time to re-enter the public awareness. They are now are quite different from anything offered to young people in the past and cover many different disciplines, not just the traditional trades. Potentially, they are the best route into the workforce for young people and for job changers who are not going to university, so I see their role as being huge and long term. Many employers say to us that they would prefer someone with GCSEs in English and Maths and a good attitude rather than someone who doesn't understand their industry."

Amarijt Basi, Principal and Chief Executive of Cornwall College commented "We are industry focused, working closely with local and regional businesses, to offer specialist training for Cornwall's key industry sectors, through apprenticeships but also through academic and vocational pathways. As the largest provider of apprenticeships west of Bristol and one of the biggest in the UK we take great pride in the contribution that our apprentices are making to the businesses that they are working in, helping to support the prosperity of the region.

Falmouth Marine School secures £3.6 million redevelopment funding

Falmouth Marine School, part of the Cornwall College Group, is delighted to announce that it has secured a £3.6 million investment to refurbish its site located on Killigrew Street in Falmouth town.



The redevelopment plans include a state-of-the-art marine engineering workshop, complete with a commercial engine room with fuel mapping and diagnostic testing equipment. There will be reconfiguration of the marine biology laboratories and classrooms to make better use of the space, with additional tanks and equipment for the marine biology students to use for their marine mammal breading programme.
